MPs claim more than £740,000 in expenses

BARNSLEY'S MPs claimed more than £740,000 in expenses, new figures show.

Data from the Independent Parliamentary Standards Authority for 2014-15 shows the four MPs who represent the borough – Dan Jarvis, Michael Dugher, John Healey and Angela Smith – claimed a total of £743,164.28 up to May 31, this year.

This is an increase of £32,581.06 on the same period for 2013-2014 and includes money claimed for staffing and office costs, travel and accommodation but not MPs' £67,059.96 salaries.

John Healey employs wife Jackie Bate, part time, as an office manager. She was paid between £10,000 and £15,000.
