Yet the Tories have completely failed to act to support refugees, leaving them to struggle in camps in Calais and elsewhere.

Stand Up To Racism organised large 'Refugees Are Welcome Here' demonstrations in London and many towns and cities, including Barnsley, in September. Many groups have organised national solidarity convoys taking aid to the refugee camp in Calais.

Half the money raised by this appeal will go to the Stand Up To Racism national Christmas Appeal.

The other half of the money raised will go to Unite the Union in Barnsley who are running vital ESOL classes for refugees.
