Why we're protesting against benefit sanctions

Wednesday 9 March 2016

More and more people are being hit by benefit sanctions which are causing increasing levels of poverty, hardship and anxiety for those who are already struggling to make ends meet.

A benefit sanction is when someone's money can be cut - for offences such as arriving minutes late to a Job Centre meeting, missing an appointment on the day of the funeral of a close family member or not applying for a job when waiting to start a new job!

Half a million people have had their benefits cut over the past year - leaving people without any money to live on.

Benefit sanctions are hitting the most vulnerable people in our communities - this has to stop.
